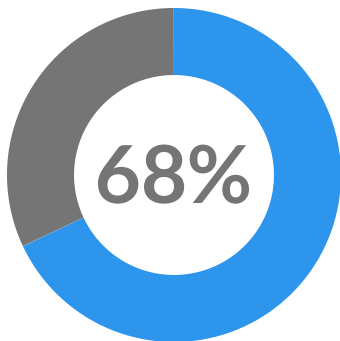

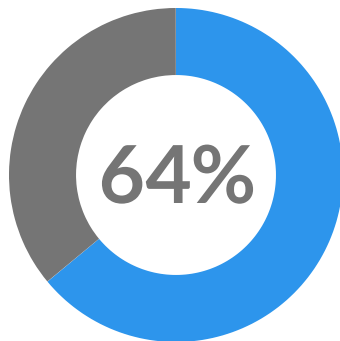

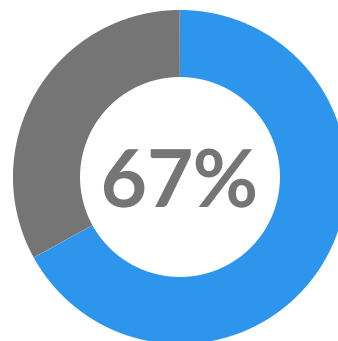
FAMILY DOCTOR

Majority (68%) of respondents go to their family doctor when they are looking for health related information



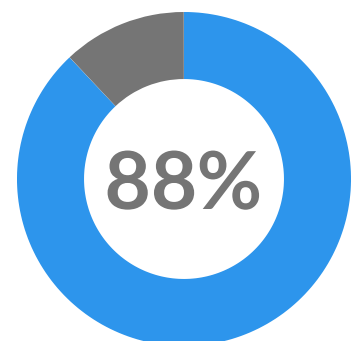
SATISFACTION
