Western Health would like to remind the public of its Visitation Policy at Sir Thomas Roddick Hospital and Western Memorial Regional Hospital.

- Visiting hours are from 2 – 9 pm, daily.
- A maximum of 2 visitors per patient may visit at a time.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult and may not be permitted in all areas.
- Please keep your visits short. Patients in hospital need time to heal and rest.
- Visitors may be asked to leave during patient treatments or at other times.
- Patients may choose not to have visitors.
- Western Health may at times limit or restrict visitation and visiting hours.

Patients in medical/surgical areas may also choose one primary support person. A primary support person is not considered a visitor, but is with the patient assisting in their recovery process by increasing their comfort level and assisting with their care while in hospital.

Visitors are reminded to practice proper hand washing when visiting the hospital. Visitors are also reminded not to visit the hospital if they have any flu like symptoms, including vomiting and diarrhea.

For visiting hours on Intensive Care, Palliative Care, Mental Health, and the Women's and Children's Health units, please check with the information desk or particular unit prior to visiting.
