## Indicator:

Initiated implementation of Primary Health Care Collaborative in Corner Brook.



The BETTER Program implemented with Corner Brook Wellness Collaborative (CBWC) and Bay St. George Medical Clinic

received BETTER screening, exceeding target of 10%



A physician and LPN were recruited and trained in EMR
